## New Programs under HB3

HB3 added \$6.5 B for the biennium in public school funding. Many of these additional dollars are tied to new programs. Learn about the programs that your district may be eligible to take advantage of including: College Career Military Readiness (CCMR) Outcomes Bonus, Teacher Incentive Allotments, CTE Innovation Opportunities, Pre-K Partnerships/Funding, and Extended Year Funding Opportunities. Spend time discussing when and how to take advantage of new programs and think through long-term budget planning implications.
